

THREE VILLAGES HALL - UPDATE

As you will know, the Three Villages Hall has been closed during April and May due to the COVID-19 situation.

The Scottish Government has now published its 'route-map' out of lockdown, and we have been considering how that will affect the Hall as we move forward into the 'post-lockdown' world.



Facilities like the Three Villages Hall are not likely to top the priority list in terms of getting back to anything like normal operations, but it should also be remembered that many of our local groups and societies do take a break over the summer in normal times. To avoid uncertainty, however, we have taken the decision that the Hall will remain closed during June and July.

We very much hope that we can re-open – **with some form of community event** – in early August, and we look forward to welcoming you back then.

Meanwhile, we have been using this 'downtime' (all within regulations) to kick-start some routine maintenance and tidying work in and around the Hall. There's plenty still to do, both inside and out – from washing down and touching up inside and outside walls to giving a good spring clean to the furniture, and much more besides.
